105.1. CURRICULUM REVIEW BY PARENTS/GUARDIANS AND STUDENTS	
1. Purpose	This policy is established to comply with the requirement of the State Board of Education that intermediate units provide parental access to information about the curriculum.
2. Authority Title 22 Sec. 4.4(d) Pol. 127	The Board adopts this policy to ensure that parents/guardians have an opportunity to review instructional materials and have access to information about the curriculum, including academic standards to be achieved, instructional materials and assessment techniques for specific programs offered by the Intermediate Unit.
3. Guidelines	The rights granted by this policy are granted to parents/guardians of students enrolled in this Intermediate Unit where the students are under the age of eighteen (18) and to the students themselves when the student is age eighteen (18) or over, unless the student is incapable of making the decision due to a disability for specific programs offered by the Intermediate Unit.
Pol. 102	Upon request by a qualifying parent/guardian or student, the Intermediate Unit will make available existing information about the curriculum, including academic standards to be achieved, instructional materials and assessment techniques for a specific program.
4. Delegation of Responsibility	The implementation procedure for this policy shall be established by the Executive Director or his/her designee.
