124. SUMMER SCHOOL	
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes its responsibility for the continuing development, assessment and improvement of student achievement in the educational programs provided by the Intermediate Unit.
2. Authority SC 502, 1901, 1906	<p>It is the policy of the Board that the Intermediate Unit may conduct a summer program for:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Correspondence school for eligible Title I students.2. Fayette County Summer School.3. Summer preschool.4. Early intervention programs.5. English Second Language programs.6. And other programs requested by constituent school districts or other customers, such as but not limited to ESY. <p>In order to support a program of summer instruction, the Board shall employ teaching and administrative staff.</p>
Title 22 Sec. 4.41	Planned instruction offered in summer school may be designed as credit or noncredit offerings.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The implementation procedure for this policy shall be established by the Executive Director or his/her designee.
