217. GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS	
1. Purpose	The Board will acknowledge each student's successful completion of the instructional program appropriate to the student's interests and needs by awarding a diploma or certificate at graduation ceremonies.

Authority Title 22 Sec. 4.11, 4.24, 4.28 Title 22 Sec. 4.24 (f)	<p>Whenever possible, special education instructional programs shall conform to the curriculum regulations of the State Board of Education.</p> <p>Students with disabilities who satisfactorily complete the special education program developed by the Individualized Education Program team, in accordance with law and state regulations, shall be granted a regular high school diploma of the school district of residence.</p>
3. Guidelines Pol. 213, 216	<p>Accurate recording of each student's achievement of academic standards shall be maintained, as required by law and state regulations.</p> <p>Students shall be informed of graduation requirements they are required to complete.</p> <p>Periodic warnings shall be issued to students in danger of not fulfilling graduation requirements.</p>
